## 5 Hidden Dangers


We have identified five prominent slip/trip and fall hazards that may directly affect your insurance premium if not prevented.



## Are any of these lurking around your restaurant?

Danger	Corrective Action
Unmarked changes in elevation. Some examples are loading and unloading entrances, steps, sidewalk to parking lot and curb stops	Highlight the elevation change with non-skid traffic paint (fluorescent colors)
Spills	Secure/Guard Spill Post "Caution Wet Floor" signs Clean up spill immediately
Potholes or surface breaks in parking lots	Inspect parking lot daily Repair immediately
Mopped or wet floors	Immediately place "Wet Floor" caution signs so that they direct traffic around mopped or wet floor
Broken or cracked sidewalks or walking surfaces	Inspect all sidewalks & walking surfaces daily and repair immediately
